

Official Rules

Thank you for your interest in the Lake Country K-88 Vocal and Piano Solo and Ensemble Festival. The festival is sponsored by Hartland Piano in conjunction with the Lake Country Music Club. The Lake Country Music Club is a local senior club in the National Federation of Music Clubs, a 501.c.3 non-profit organization. NFMC is chartered by the United States Congress with an envoy at the United Nations, and is the oldest and largest music non-profit organization in the United States.

Purpose

The purpose of the Lake Country K-88 Vocal and Piano Solo and Ensemble Festival is to provide a gentle, positive adjudicated experience for piano students. The goal is to foster excellence in musicianship and teaching in the Lake Country Area.

Eligibility

Piano and Voice students of all ages who study with a current member of the Lake Country Music Club are eligible to enter the festival. Events in solo and ensembles of all sizes will be held. Students may enter a solo or an ensemble or both, but may enter each event only once per year. Repertoire

Repertoire may be selected at the teacher's discretion. Memorization is not required, but students must present one original copy (i.e. not a photocopy) of their music to the judge. Students who do not have one original copy will not be allowed to perform. If your piano student is playing from photocopies, it's a good idea to paper clip the copies to another book or stiff cardboard to ensure that it remains in place on the piano's music desk during the student's audition. Digitally purchased music which displays the name of the purchaser is acceptable.

During Auditions

Auditions are open and parents, siblings, family members, and other students may be present in the room while your student auditions if space permits. Please be respectful and silence cell phones and other electronic devices and remain quiet during student's auditions. The judge may ask observers to leave if he or she feels that observers are compromising a student's ability to perform their audition well.

To Enter

Register each student via this [Google Form](#). For ensemble events, fill out only one rating sheet per ensemble. The judge will make comments for all members of the ensemble on one rating sheet. It is the teacher's responsibility to make photocopies of the judge's comments to distribute to all members of the ensemble. Collect entry fees from your students, and then [pay your entry fees online](#). Entry fees are non-refundable. Students must be entered and entry fees must be paid no later than **February, 20, 2026. Late entries will not be accepted.**

After the Festival

Results and rating sheets will be available at the end of judging. Participating students through 8th grade will receive medals. Students in grade 9 - adult will receive certificates. Teachers are responsible to pick up their student's results. Results will be available from the front counter at Hartland Piano for one week following the festival.
